PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2030-6.015 Application, Renewal, Relicensure, and Miscellaneous Fees. The board is amending subsection (1)(R).

PURPOSE: This amendment reduces the biennial renewal fee for corporations.

(1) The following fees are established by the Missouri Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Professional Land Surveyors, and Landscape Architects:

(R) Corporate Renewal Fee [~~\$100~~] \$ 50
