PROPOSED RULE

20 CSR 2150-2.270 Discipline of Assistant Physician Licensure

PURPOSE: This rule sets forth the causes of discipline for assistant physician licensure.

(1) The board may suspend or revoke any assistant physician license for the causes and pursuant to the procedures set forth in sections 334.100, 334.102, and 334.103, RSMo.

AUTHORITY: sections 334.036 and 334.125, RSMo Supp. 2014. Original rule filed June 29, 2016.

PUBLIC COST: The cost of this proposed rule to state agencies or political subdivisions will vary depending upon the cost of any appeals to discipline. Estimates for staff time are two thousand, nine hundred thirty-seven dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2,937.75) to five thousand, two hundred fifty-three dollars and sixty cents (\$5,253.60) annually for the life of the rule with a projected annual increase of 3%. It is anticipated that the costs will recur for the life of the rule, may vary with inflation, and are expected to increase at the rate projected by the Legislative Oversight Committee.

PRIVATE COST: The cost of this proposed rule to private entities will vary depending upon the costs associated with denials and appeals. Those costs are undeterminable due to the variance in application deficiencies and cost associated with licensees retaining legal counsel and appeal expenses.
