Pursuant to section 41.950, RSMo, which was enacted in 2011, every professional licensing board shall establish, by rule, the procedure for renewal of a license held by a licensee on active military duty and for discipline of a licensee on active military duty. This proposed rule is necessary to implement that statute.

As a result of this proposed rule, the division is able to set forth the procedure for renewal of a license held by a licensee on active military duty and for discipline of a license or registration on active military duty.

Please explain how your agency has involved small businesses in the development of the proposed rule.

Active military tattoo, body piercing or branding licensees have a stake in this rule. At this time they have not received a copy of the proposed changes. After the proposed rule amendment is filed with the Secretary of State's Office, a public notice for this rulemaking will be published in the Missouri Register and posted on the board's website. Any comments received prior to the close of the public comment period will be considered and addressed prior to filing the final order of rulemaking.

There are no monetary costs or benefits related to the implementation of or compliance with this amendment.

This rule will allow active military members, who have been called to active duty for a period of more than thirty (30) days, and who have had any license lapse, the ability to renew/reinstate such license without penalty.

This rule also states, if during the time a licensee is on active military duty, and the office decides to pursue any disciplinary action against any license of the licensee, the office shall stay any action until at least sixty (60) days after the end of the active military duty.

The rule will cost both public and private entities no more than \$500 in the aggregate.
