



Dear Ms. Mealy:

The Missouri Gaming Commission (MGC) has conducted a thorough review of their rules as outlined in §536.325. After careful consideration, it has been determined that only the rules in 11 CSR 45 Chapters 4 and 30 may have some affect on small businesses.

While these rules may have some effect on small businesses, these rules merely substantially codify statute §§313.005 to 313.080 (Bingo) and §§313.800 to 313.850 (Excursion Gambling Boats). See §536.300.4. Furthermore, while 11 CSR 45-4.430 allows the Commission to waive certain licensing requirements under excursion gambling that may effect small businesses, please be aware that §313.806 states that the Commission "shall" impose a fee that covers the cost of any license investigation conducted by MGC thus requiring MGC to recover the cost of issuing a license. Likewise, while 11 CSR 45-30.520 allows waiver of some Bingo rules that may effect small businesses, the Constitution and Statutes governing Bingo set certain requirements that cannot be waived. If you have any questions regarding MGC's rules excursion gambling or bingo, please feel free to contact me.
